

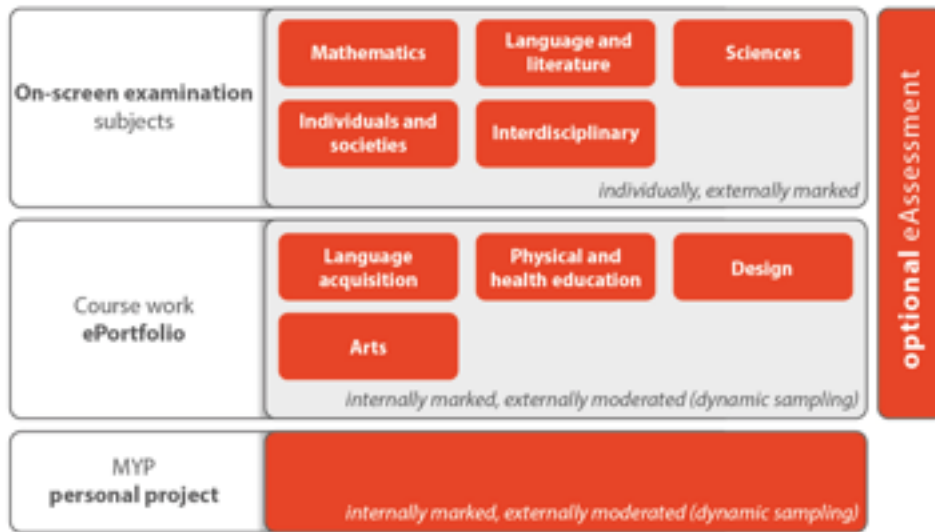

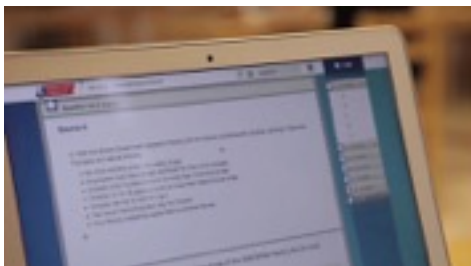


It's important for students to be familiar with the on-screen examination interface. Think about how you'll use the familiarization tool and supporting resources.
